THE PARENTS' AGREEMENT

4. Support the teacher and ensure the completion of all homework assignments.

8. Supervise the amount of time my child spends playing video games and monitor the quality of each.
9. Check my child's behavior/academic progress by reviewing daily planner/behavior chart.

11. Ensure proper documentation/excuses are brought to school should my child be absent
